

How to make the 'Fireworks Bow'

Here's What You'll Need

Feel free to use any colors/widths of ribbons you like to create your 'Fireworks Bow'!

- (1) 24" Silver Metallic Edged White Ribbon (1/8" wide)
 - (1) 24" Denim Blue Taffeta Edge Ribbon (3/8" wide)
 - (1) 36" Red Picot Edged Ribbon (3/16" wide)
 - (1) 36" White Picot Edged Ribbon (3/16" wide)

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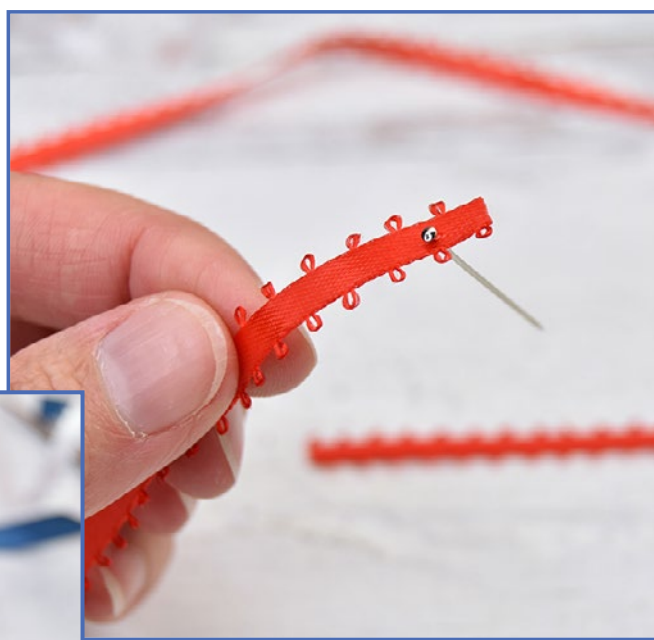




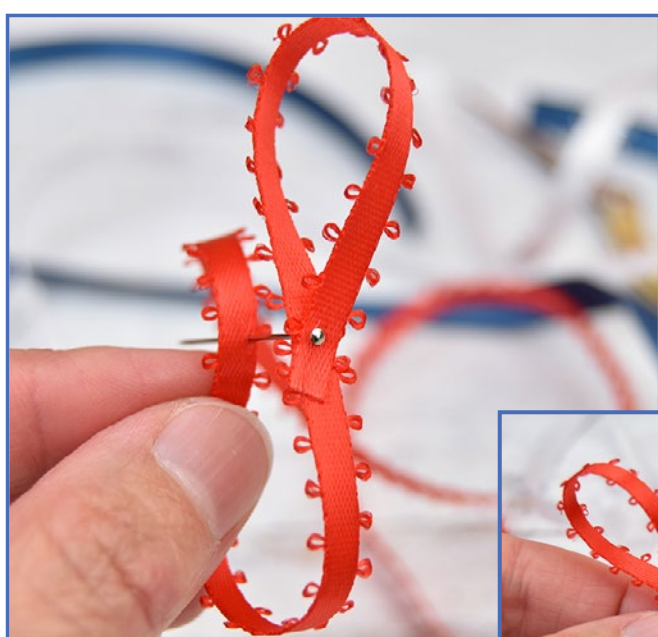
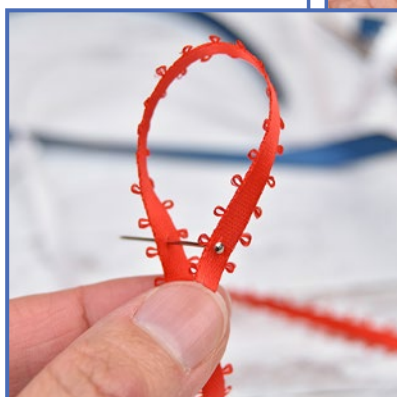
Start by cutting off 12" of both your red and white picot-edged ribbon, and setting those 12" pieces aside for a moment. We'll use the longer (24") pieces of each to make bows.



Starting with the red ribbon, place a pin through one end. Then, loop 3" - 4", and pin through it again, as shown:

Continue looping and pinning the ribbon in 3" - 4" sections until you reach the end of the ribbon...

...and you'll have created a bow!



Repeat the same steps to create a second bow with the 24" piece of white picot-edged ribbon.



And finally, repeat once more to create a third bow with the 24" piece of blue satin ribbon. Set all three bows aside for a moment.



Cut the 12" pieces of red and white picot-edge ribbon in half, to make (2) 6" pieces each.



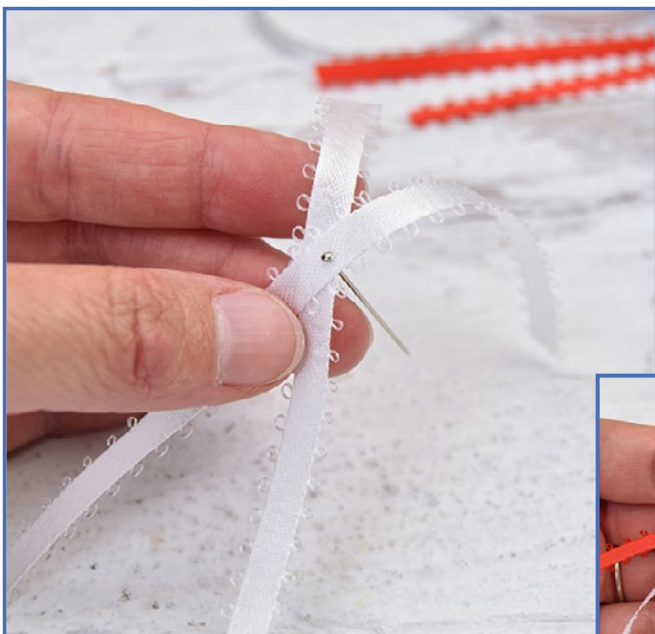


Cut the 24" piece of metallic-edged white satin in half twice, to make (4) 6" pieces.



Pin the blue bow to the top of your ornament, directly over the raw edges of the band.





Pin through the center of both white picot-edge ribbon strips, and then through the center of both red ribbon strips. You'll have 4 strips on your pin.

Pin this directly over your blue bow.



Now pin the white picot-edged ribbon bow on top of these.





Pin through the center of all four of the metallic-edged white ribbon strips.



Pin this over the white bow.



Last but not least, pin the red picot-edged ribbon bow on top of everything.



Your 'Fireworks Bow' is done!



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
