Feel free to use any colors/widths of ribbons  
you like to create your *Gift Bow*!

- (1) 52" Twilight Satin Radiance Ribbon w/ Gold Shimmer (3/8" wide)  
» You'll need (1) 28" and (1) 24" piece if you follow our example.
  - (1) 24" Metallic Gold Sparkle Ribbon (1/4" wide)

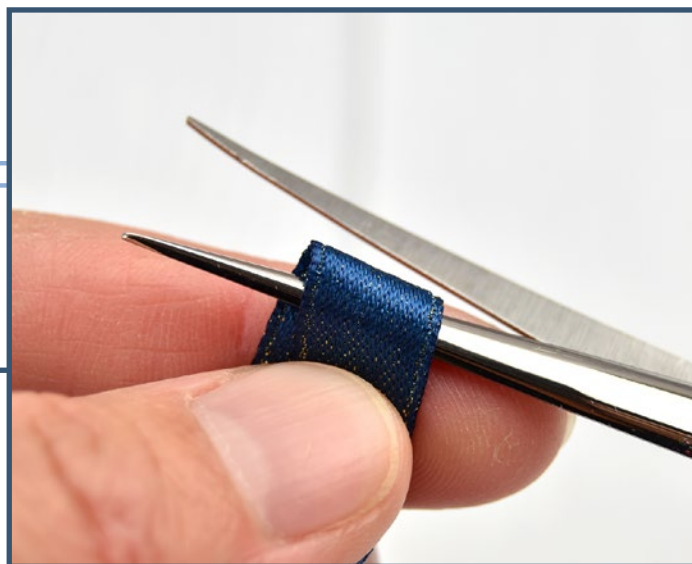
Cut 28" from the longer piece of ribbon. Set the remaining 24" aside for a moment.



Place the ends together, forming a fold at the other end.



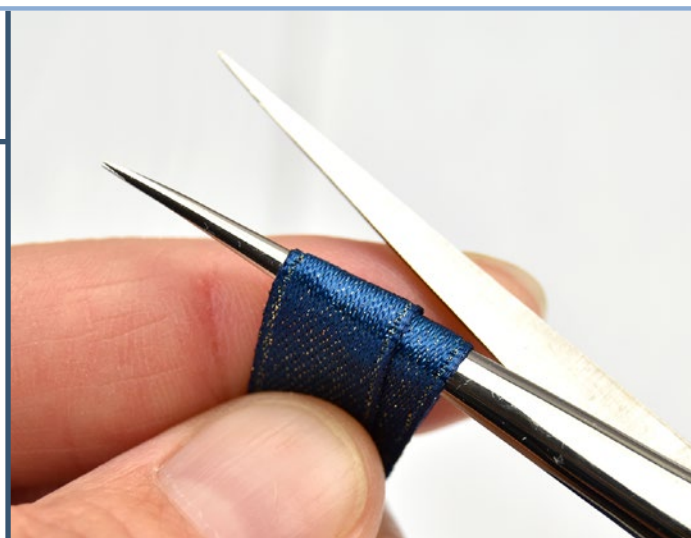
Cut the ribbon in half at the fold you've formed.



Your ribbon is now in two strips. Fold these in half again, forming folds at the other ends.



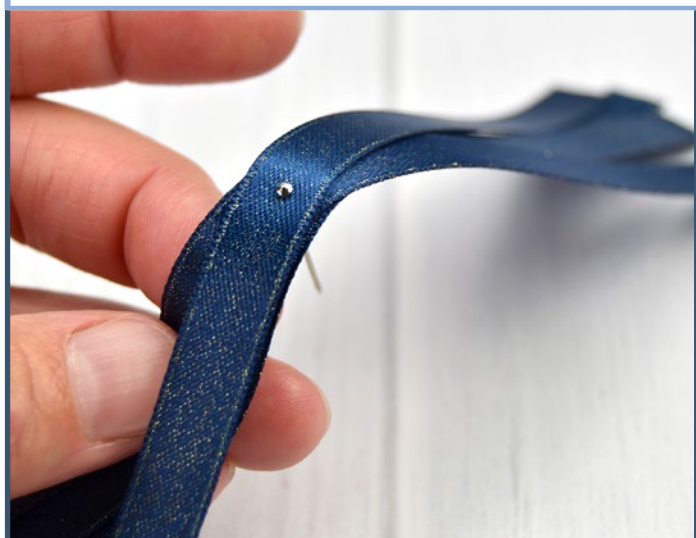
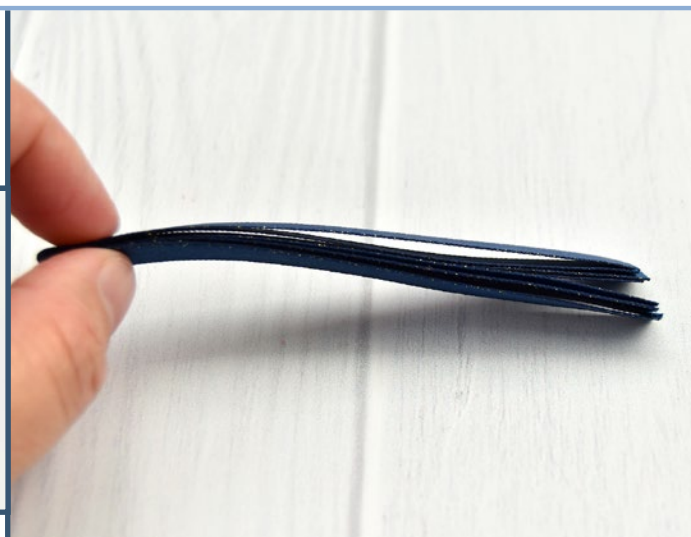
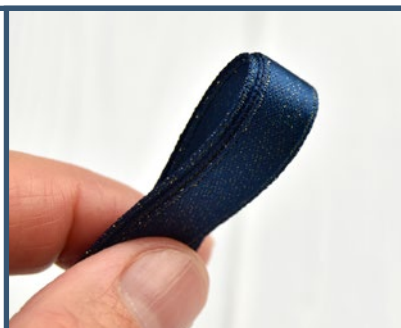
Cut them in half again at these folds.



Now you have four strips of ribbon.

Fold them in half one more time  
(but do NOT cut them this time).

*Like This*

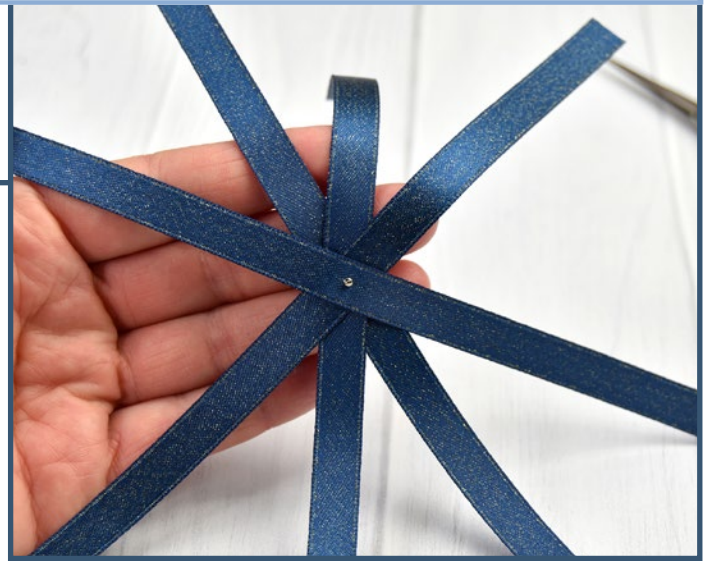


This time, pin through that fold,  
holding the four strips together  
on the pin.

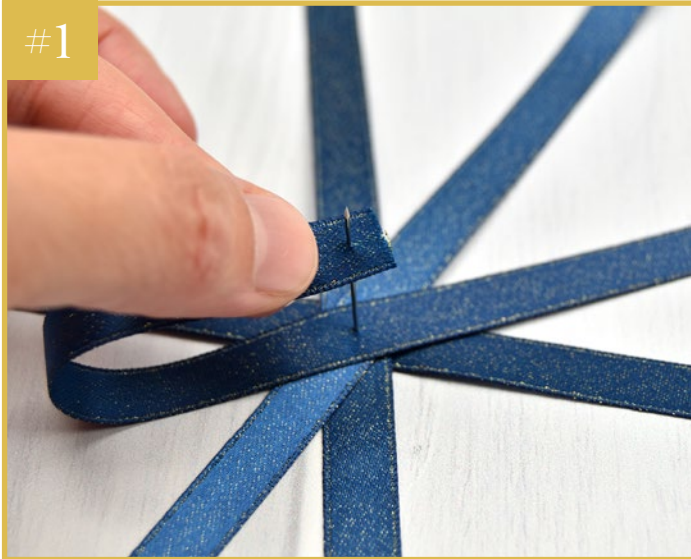




Keeping them on the pin, spread out the four strips.



One by one, fold each end back and onto the pin.



Continue until you've folded back the eight ends of the ribbon.  
You've created a beautiful bow!



Pin this bow to the top of your ornament, directly over the raw edges of the band.



Repeat the same steps to create two more bows with the other pieces of ribbon.

Because these two pieces of ribbon are a little shorter, the loops will automatically be a little smaller, creating a 'tiered' look to your ornament topper!





Place them on top of your ornament, directly over the first bow.



Your *Gift Bow* is done!
